The spirit of Louis XVI in your garden! How classy! The designer Frédéric Sofia takes a chic, contemporary new look at the oval-backed chair. With 4 slender, straight legs on flared feet to stand firmly on the grass; and rounded angles between the base and the seat, the piece is reminiscent of the Arne Jacobsen Ant Chair by Fritz Hansen and the furniture style of the 1950s. Its backrest is reminiscent of moucharabiehs, the lattice work panels in Mediterranean countries that keep out prying eyes while letting the wind blow through. The repetitive pattern of flowers and diamond shapes adds a touch of modernity and femininity. In this intricate piece of work, Fermob shows its mastery of perforation techniques. The practical aspect is there too: these chairs are durable, stackable and easy to handle. Are they classic? Or vintage? They are, in fact, timeless. Here is a masterpiece from the Lorette collection. Available in the 24 colours of the Fermob colour chart, it will lend character and softness to all the furniture sets, and especially to the other members of the Lorette tribe.
